For 2016 it has been transported 68 million tons of loads and 21,1 million passengers.







Railway transport

- in 2001 was completed the construction of the railway line "Navoi-Uchkuduk-Sultanuizdag" with a length of 341 km
- in 2007 was completed the construction of the railway line "Tashguzar-Boysun-Kumkurgan" with a length of 220 km.
- In 2016 was completed the construction of 123.2 kilometers of new electrified railroad Angren-Pap, in which was built the tunnel "Kamchik" with a length of 19.2 kilometers.
