



- **❖ Land re-adjustment program in Dhaka**








## Major Achievements: Shift (Goal 4-7)







- Strategic Transport plan for Dhaka (2016-2035)
- MRT 6 and BRT 3 will be in operation by 2020
- **❖** Feasibility study of 3 MRT & 1 BRT
- Bus route francization & replacement of bus terminals
- Enhancement of capacity of rail & waterway to carry Passenger & Fright
- Introduction of Water Taxi in Dhaka





## Major Achievements: Shift (Goal 4-7)







- Designated lane for NMT in some selected urban roads and inter-city roads
- **❖** Foot path with tactile track in urban area
- **❖** By cycle getting popular
- 90 Overbridge & 4 underpass for pedestrian crossing
- Staggered Working times for government offices, financial institutions and educational institutions
- One busy street in Dhaka is declared "Car free" on the first Friday of every month







# Major Achievements: Improve (Goal 8-12)

- Introducing Hybrid vehicle and tax incentive
- Both Private and Public Vehicles runs with CNG
- \*Road map to reduce the sulfur level (50 ppm by 2023)
- **❖ Modern Vehicle Inspection (VIC) center in Dhaka**
- ❖ Passenger Information System (PIS) at all major Railway Stations
- **❖** Passenger and freight movement by waterway is increasing
- **Expansion Rail network**
- Upgradation of Major highway to 4 lane highway with NMT lane





#### Major Achievements: Cross Cutting (Goal 13-20)

- Improvement of Black spots on National highways
- \*Road safety in Primary level Education Curriculum
- Government declared 22 October as "National safe road day"
- Awareness Program on Road Safety
- Elevators have been installed at foot over bridges to ease the crossing for Child, Elderly, Women and Person with disability.
- Special bus services for women and students
- Dhaka Transport Coordination Authority (DTCA)
- \*Road infrastructure project with PPP

- **Lack of Coordination between different agencies involved in Transport Sector**
- **\*** Lack of institutional capacity
- **❖ Integrated Transport Planning disrupted with Land Constraint**
- **❖ Shortage of Natural Gas**
- **Fragmented Public Transport Sector**
- **❖** Insufficient Budget
- \*Lack of awareness of road user
