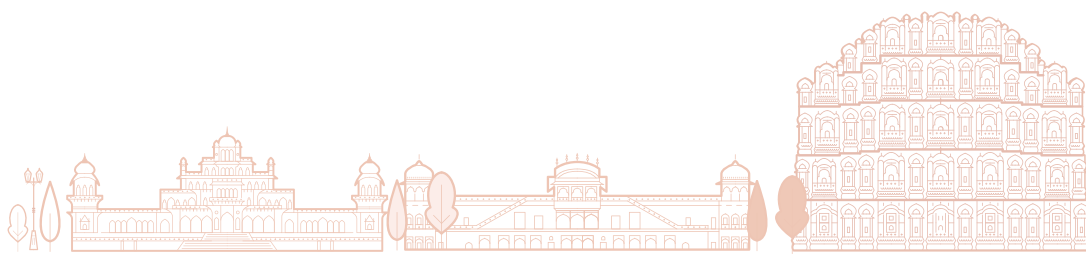

PRE-ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

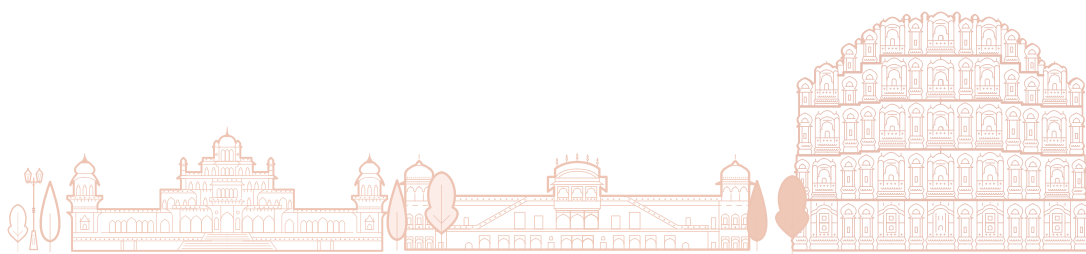
Required documents:

- Passport
- Letter of invitation
- Hotel/accommodation booking confirmation
- Visa
- Letter of nomination for the forum issued by organisation

Currency: The local currency is the Indian Rupee (INR). Credit cards and UPI payments are widely accepted. It is advisable to carry some cash for small purchases.

Weather: Outside temperatures in Jaipur may range from 18°C (64°F) in the morning to 30°C (86°F) in the afternoon.

Time Zone: Jaipur operates on Indian Standard Time (IST), which is UTC +5:30.





ARRIVAL IN JAIPUR

Airport transfer

Upon arrival at the Jaipur International Airport, delegates should proceed to the **Welcome Desk**. Airport transfers will be provided for those staying at one of the hotels designated for the forum.

If the delegate misses this facility or if they have booked accommodation at a different hotel, registered taxis, app-based ride services (such as Ola, Uber, etc.), or pre-arranged hotel transportation may be used.

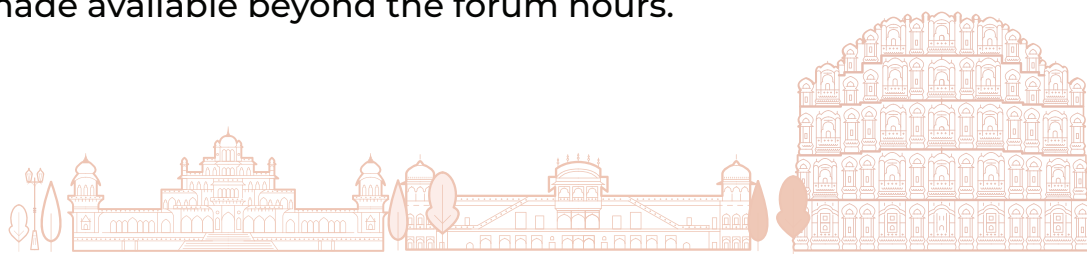

- Delegates may contact the help desk at the reception of the abovementioned hotels while checking in and collect their Delegate Kits.
- Delegates may confirm if their hotel booking includes breakfast.
- Delegates shall be responsible for any additional costs incurred by them, including laundry, mini bar and other miscellaneous expenses.
- The standard voltage in India is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Power plugs and sockets of type C, type D and type M are used. It is advised to carry an adapter, if required.

Reaching the forum venue

- Shuttles to the forum venue shall ply from the designated hotels.
- Delegates are requested to be ready on time for their shuttle on the days of the forum.
- Delegates staying in a different hotel may kindly make their own arrangements to reach the venue.

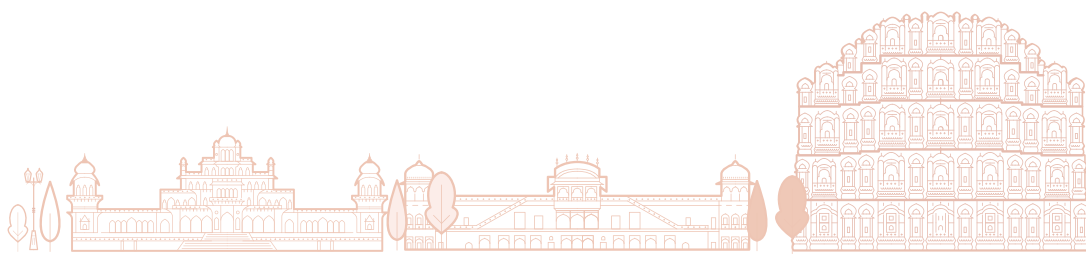
Scan to locate RIC on Google Maps

Venue Facilities

- **Conference Halls And Meeting Rooms:** The conclave will be held across main conference halls and breakout rooms. Each space is equipped with modern AV systems, internet, and comfortable seating.

- **Emergency:** First aid and emergency medical services will be available at the venue.

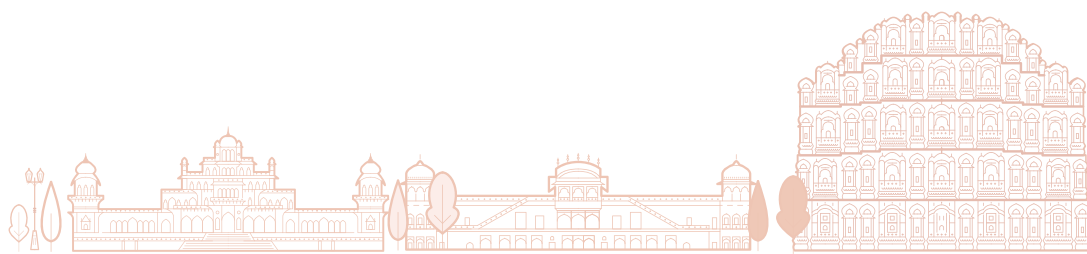




Security Requirements

Baggage scanners shall be placed at the venue for screening. Delegates must refrain from carrying prohibited items such as

- Weapons and firearms, ammunition, knives, hazardous materials, explosives, fireworks, or flammable materials

 - Illegal & controlled substances, alcohol, banned medications
 - Electronic & recording devices, professional cameras, tripods, drones, or audio recording devices (unless approved)
 - Laser pointers or noisemakers (e.g., air horns, megaphones), and other disruptive items

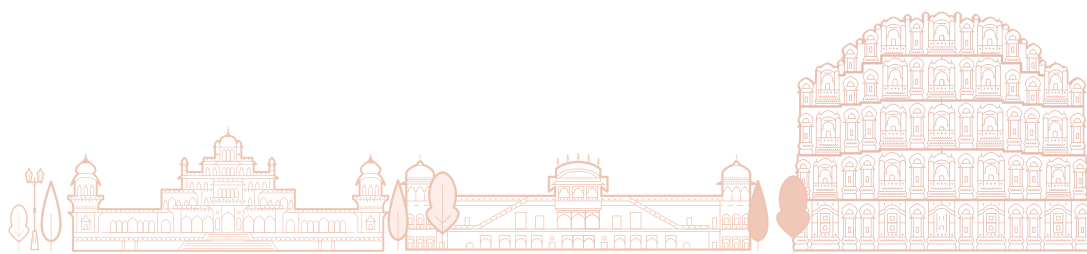


HEALTH AND MEDICAL RECOMMENDATIONS
