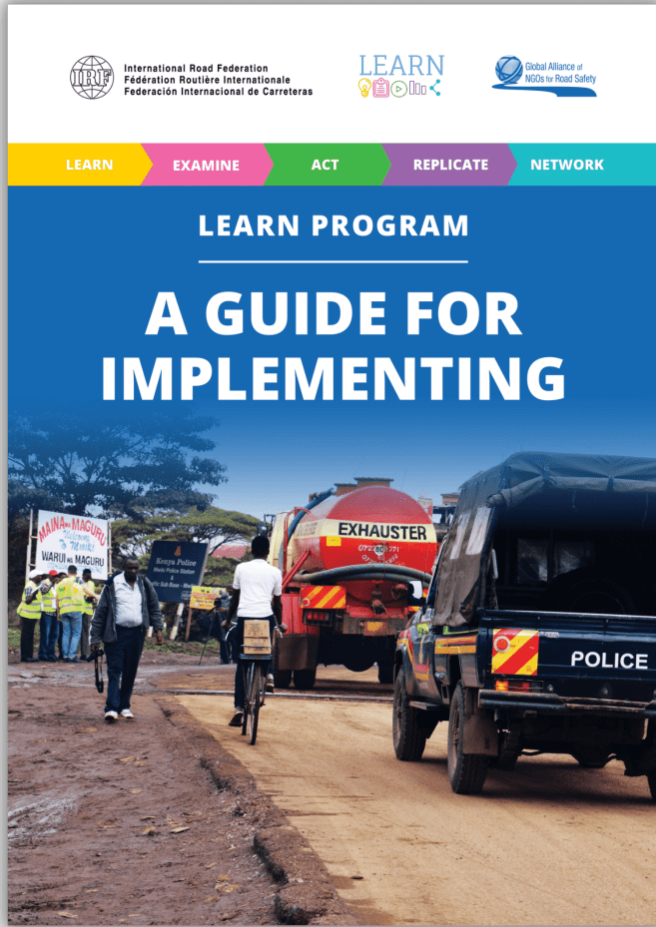

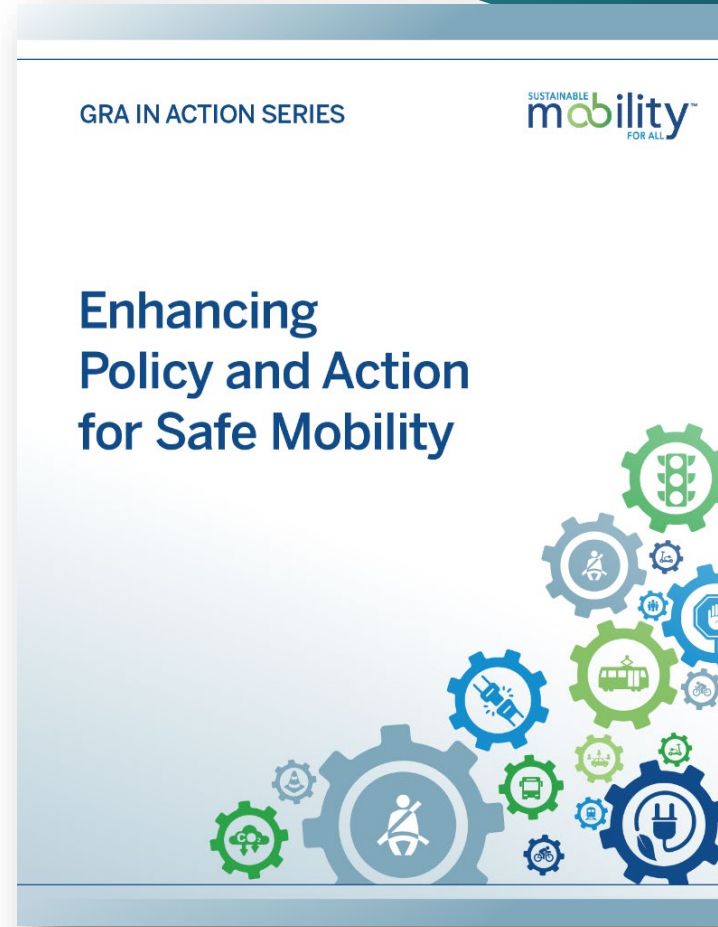

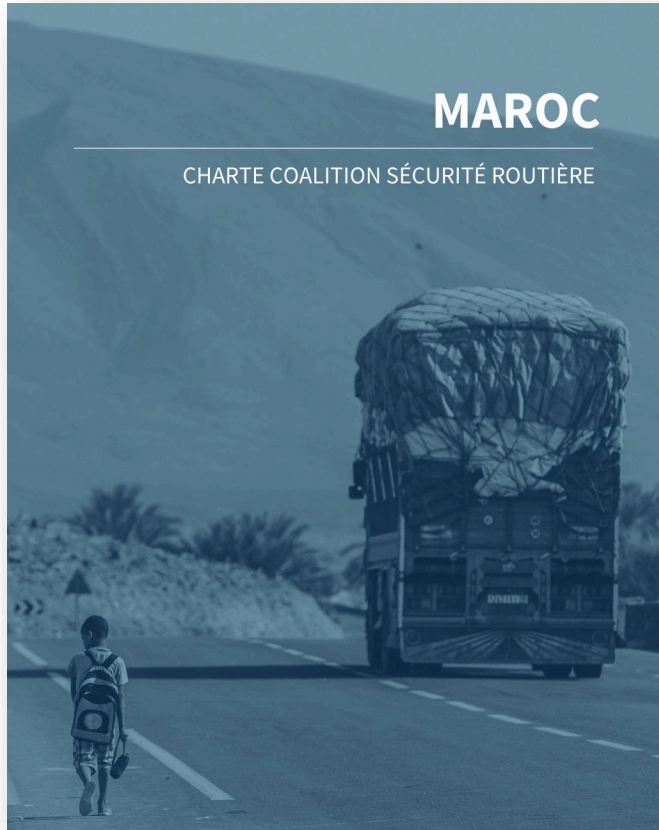

The project has helped to embed improvements in how thousands of new and existing kilometres of Tanzania’s road network will be designed, upgraded and managed for improved road safety now and in the future.

Safety data expanded to more than 10,000km using the iRAP Methodology



Launch of TanRAP, a locally owned and led Road Assessment Programme (RAP)

Recommendations for revision of the **Tanzania Road Geometric Design Manual**



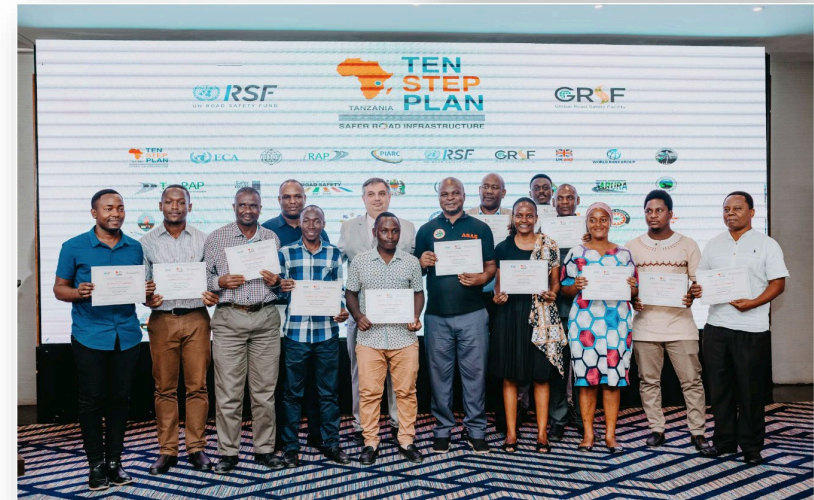
