2<sup>nd</sup> Drafting Committee meeting-cum-experts consultation on the prezero draft of the new 3R and Circular Economy Declaration (2024-2034) – successor of the Hanoi 3R Declaration (2013-2023) 30 Nov. 2022 – 01 Dec. 2022

**Background:** The Ha Noi 3R declaration – Sustainable 3R Goals for Asia and the Pacific for 2013-2023, which was adopted by the 4<sup>th</sup> Regional 3R and Circular Economy Forum in Asia and the Pacific, 18-20 March 2013, Hanoi, Viet Nam will come to an end in 2023. The Ha Noi 3R Declaration with it's 33 goals and a comprehensive set of monitoring indicators is the first regional declaration on the promotion of 3R and sustainable waste management in Asia-Pacific. There is an expressed need to initiate discussions on a possible follow-up agreement to the Declaration.

The new 3R Declaration will act as a catalyst for transformational change in the resource and waste management sector in Asia-Pacific. This will include enabling changes to policy, institutional frameworks, financing models, data management approaches, and application of various 3R and circular economy technologies. Further, the new 3R Declaration with a strong tracking framework and multi-layer cooperation and with an aim towards achieving a zero-waste future and more country-based implementation mechanisms, would be in the forefront of new collaborative approaches and interagency cooperation to enhance actions towards achieving the SDGs and other international agreements such as the Paris Agreement, NUA, Sendai Framework, among others.

In conducting this discussion, it will be important to build on the strengths of the Ha Noi 3R Declaration (2013-2023) and address its shortcomings while taking account the changing focus in resource and waste domain. It is important that the new Declaration is aligned with the objectives of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the underlined SDGs.

The 1<sup>st</sup> drafting committee meeting (25-26 August 2022, Japan) underscored the importance of sustainable management of natural resources and lasting supply security of natural resources for achieving the SDGs. Among others, different materials, different sectors of economy and transitioning from conventional to circular economy by eliminating waste and redesigning industrial metabolism was emphasized in order to achieve
