Implementation of 3Rs in Vanuatu

- The 2018 ban on single-use plastics (plastic bags, straws, and polystyrene containers) Reg order No. 15, 16 & 17.
- Support Private sectors with recycling programs
- Establishment of the first composting site in Vanuatu in 2022.
- Community and stakeholder involvement.

- Development of the legal framework for Product Stewardship Scheme.
- Introduction of the Container Deposit Scheme to encourage recycling of beverage containers.
- Partnerships with businesses to promote recycling and sustainable practices.
 - a. Case Study: Vanuatu Environmental Science Society (VESS) recycling programs.
 - b. Introduction of the composting site
 - c. SPREP pilot project on oil refinery facility.
 - d. Expected outcomes: Increased recycling rates, job creation, and reduced litter.
