1. Party: BASEL Convention – Environmental Sustainability, Waste Management & Pollution Control

2. Party: Stockholm Convention – Public Health, Chemical Safety & Protection of Vulnerable Populations (women, children)

3. Ratified: WAIGANI Convention – Regional Cooperation, Marine Protection, and Radioactive Waste Exclusion

4. National Sustainable Development Strategy 2019-2030

5. Environmental Management & Climate Change Act 2020

The Environment Act is the cornerstone legal tool for the protecting Nauru's environment, that strengthens governance and aligns us with the international framework.

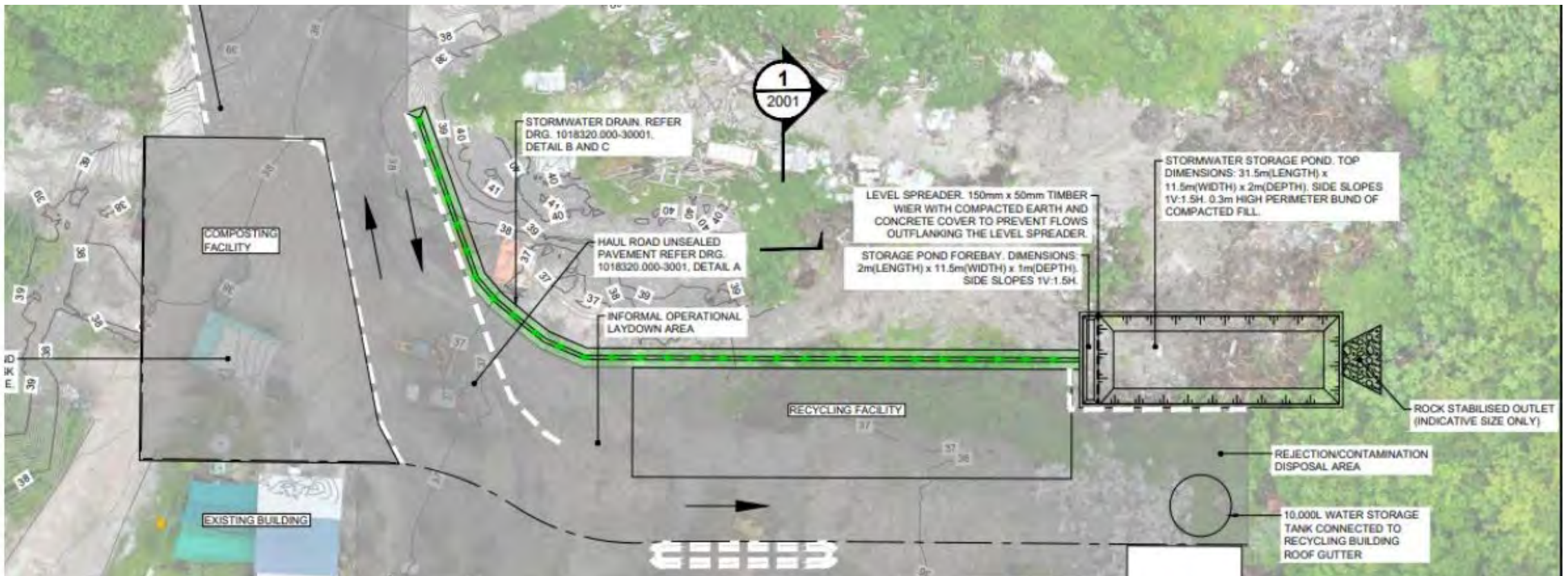
