

Partnerships with the private sector

- Private sector: formal AND informal
- Ownership (international organizations are only facilitators)
- Credit schemes between 5 and 50 thousand US dollars
- Clear benefits, clear responsibilities
- Feasibility study and benchmarking
- Example: Plastic bags in the Philippines
 - Strengthened informal sector and cement industry
 - Capacity building
 - Adapted technologies
