


  - Market and household composting








#### 3Rs in Industrial Waste



## 3Rs for New and Emerging Wastes

- National Waste Management and Pollution Control Strategy
- Waste Management Act
- Signatory to Waigani Convention
- Luganville Municipality: used printer toner cartridge recycling in partnership with Croxley Recycling and Pacific Direct Line shipping company
- Scoping of mobile phone recycling with Telecom Vanuatu Ltd
- Development of used oil regulations to provide framework for a Used Oil Stewardship system

## 3Rs for Cross Cutting Issues

- Climate Change and DRR policy highlights sustainable production priorities and synergies for renewable energy and waste management financing
- Partnerships forged between local councils, communities and private sector for recycling or reuse
- Community based recycling and advocacy for waste management e.g. Wan Smol Bag Theatre Group

## Challenges

- Human Capacity: limited at all levels
- *Finance*: inadequate financial resources to support sustainable waste management
- Technology/Infrastructure: limited access to appropriate infrastructure e.g. collection vehicle, special wastes treatment facilities/apparatus
- *Natural Disasters*: generation of high volumes of debris beyond local management capabilities
- *Governance*: low priority for waste management
