		In order to respond the "Notice on Promoting Drop-and-Hook Development" (2009), which was co-issued by MOT, NDRC, MPS, GDC <sup>1</sup> , and CIRC <sup>2</sup> , MOT and NDRC co-issued the "Implementation Plan on Drop-and-Hook Pilot Project" on 9 November 2010. The purpose of the drop-and-hook pilot project is to enhance the transport operation efficiency, and therefore to reduce energy-use and emissions, by increasing the share of drop-and-hook modes within freight transport.
		These could cover, amongst others, (a) platforms for trailers to loading/unloading cargoes; (b) yards and roads for drop-and-hook operations; (c) loading facilities, standard trays and accessory facilities; (d) information system and technical facilities for "drop-and-hook" operation; (e) tractors and trailers.
