Background of EST

- 2004 Lao PDR became a member of Environmentally Sustainable Transport (EST) Forum
- 2006- The EST project entrusted MCTPC (MPWT) with WREA (MONRE) supported by UNCRD
- 2008 Division of Transport Techniques and Environment "DTE" was established under the Department of Transport to Develop the EST Strategy in Lao PDR
- 2009- the final draft of EST Strategy was approved by the National Environmental Committee (NEC) chaired by Deputy Prime Minister.

UNCRD: United Nation Centre for Regional Development

MCTPC: Ministry of Communication Transportation Post and Construction

MPWT: Ministry of Public Works and Transport

WREA: Water Resource Environmental Administration MONRE: Ministry of Natural Resource and Environment DTE: Division of Transport Techniques and Environment

- •Since 2010 the draft of EST Strategy in Lao PDR has been revised through the streering committee for development Land Transport Master Plan in Lao PDR (LTMP) Chaired by Vice Minister of MPWT
- Draft of Land Transport Master Plan in Lao PDR (LTMP) in comply with the VII National Socio-Economic Development Plan (NSEDP), and related new laws:
 - -The LTMP consists of 5 thematic Areas:
 - 1. Road Traffic Safety
 - 2. Road Passenger Transport
 - 3. Transport Logistics
 - 4. Environmentally Sustainable Transport "EST"
 - 5. Capacity Building and Strengthening Transport Enterprise

- Public Transport Planning and Transportation Demand Management (TDM)
- Non- Motorized Transport (NMT)
- Vehicle emission control, standards, and clean fuels, and inspection & maintenance (I/M)
- Strengthening Knowledge base, awareness, and public participation
- Road safety and maintenance


