# Critical challenges faced in Waste Management

- 2. Lack of facilities to support in managing the waste;
- 3. Low enforcement
- 4. Lack/minimum financial support from the state or other donors.
- 5. Lack of Technology

## Major Plan regarding to Waste Management



**Stage 1:** 5 years, 200m x 200m area

Stage 2: 15 years, 400m x 200m area

Stage 3: 25 years, 630 x 200m area

Subsequent stages towards slopes with life up to 2100
