MISSING MIDDLE

- ➤ Backbone of economy, Municipalities & SMEs generally out of scope, while they are at the front line of CE
- **➣** Too many and too small to be considered
- **➤ NOT of enough interest to policy makers & investors**
- ➤ Missed/Missing opportunities for deeply rooted transformative change
- ➤ Necessary responsible first steps in the CE process with SMEs & Local Communities, since rooted in Ecosystems
- ➤ Renewed attention for "Think Global, Act Local", but <u>Act</u> Local remains limited
