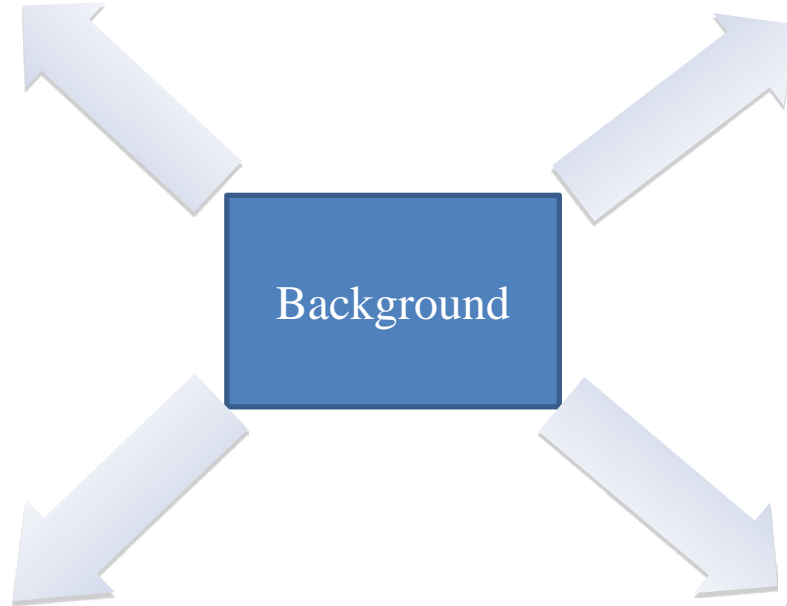

In the framework of implementation of relevant State Programs for 10 years, 8.3 th.km roads of republican and local status were built or repaired, 307 new bridges and viaducts were constructed or repaired, airports in Nakhchivan, Ganja, Lenkeren, Zaqatala, Qabala and Yevlakh were put into operation
