 - ▶ 7 October 2016 Urban Transport Advisor started working
 - ▶ 7 February 2017 published invitations for firms to shortlist to bid for Project Implementation Consultant contract
 - ▶ 20 March 2017 open applications received
 - ▶ May 2017 invite proposals from shortlisted firms for Project Implementation Consultant contract
 - ▶ November 2017 mobilize the Project Implementation Consultants
 - ▶ 2018-2019 finalize design, bid documents and management set-up
 - ▶ 2019-2020 bidding for goods, works and service
 - ▶ 2020 Work and supply start
