On a motion of International Center for the Best Environmental Technologies (ICBET) which acts as Sub-Regional Secretariat for Russia and EurAsEC countries IPLA Global Forum-2015 is held in Moscow on 6-8 October 2015, alongside with the 5th International scientific-practical conference «Environmental problems of Moscow» dedicated to 15th anniversary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of Moscow.

The main objectives of the Forum are:

- Combining the efforts and capabilities of state and municipal authorities, business community, academia and the general public interested in the development of a modern system of waste management in the Russian Federation and other EAEU countries:

-Finding the solutions and formulate the approaches to minimize the landfill based on international experience, to establish the resource-efficient nation, including by maximum waste recovery and the future use of secondary resources;

Reputable international Forum will result in establishing the permanent expert platform IPLA - RUSSIA on the information and experience exchange in the environmental field, as well as to support the business community engaged in waste management. On the basis of the expert platform IPLA - RUSSIA the Expert-Coordinating Council and International Centre for Waste Management, building and development of waste recycling industry's infrastructure in Russia and other countries of the Customs Union will be formed.

One of the resulting documents of the Forum will be "Moscow IPLA Declaration on Interregional Cooperation for Waste Exchange and Resource Recovery towards Circular Economic Development". The final documents of the Global Forum will form a long-term Program of Waste Management System development in the Russian Federation, based on interregional cooperation and waste management industry formation in Russia. The program will be presented to the Government of the Russian Federation.

Science-Policy-Business-Community Interface. Towards a Resource Efficient Nation: Minimum Landfilling and Maximum Resource Recovert

IPLA Global Forums are held annually on the territories of different countries. Republic of Korea, Sweden and Brazil were earlier honored to conduct it. On a motion of International Center for the Best Environmental Technologies (ICBET) which acts as Sub-Regional Secretariat for Russia and EurAsEC countries IPLA Global Forum-2015 is held in Moscow on 6-8 October 2015, alongside with the 5th International scientific-practical conference "Environmental problems of Moscow" dedicated to 15th anniversary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection of Moscow.

The main objectives of the Forum are:- Combining the efforts and capabilities of state and municipal authorities, business community, academia and the general public interested in the development of a modern system of waste management in the Russian Federation and other EAEU countries;

-Finding the solutions and formulate the approaches to minimize the landfill based on international experience, to establish the resource-efficient nation, including by maximum waste recovery and the future use of secondary resources; Reputable international Forum will result in establishing the permanent expert platform IPLA - RUSSIA on the information and experience exchange in the environmental field, as well as to support the business community engaged in waste management. On the basis of the expert platform IPLA - RUSSIA the Expert-Coordinating Council and International Centre for Waste Management, building and development of waste recycling industry's infrastructure in Russia and other countries of the Customs Union will be formed.

One of the resulting documents of the Forum will be "Moscow IPLA Declaration on Interregional Cooperation for Waste Exchange and Resource Recovery towards Circular Economic Development"

The final documents of the Global Forum will form a long-term Program of Waste Management System development in the Russian Federation, based on interregional cooperation and waste management industry formation in Russia. The program will be presented to the Government of the Russian Federation.

About IPLA

Local authorities (LAs) of emerging and developing economies face capacity constraints in terms of technological, financial, institutional, and policy aspects in implementing waste management infrastructure and associated services.

The rising volume and complexity of waste streams are posing challenges to LAs threatening human health and ecosystem as well as the security of resources.


At the Intersessional Conference of the Nineteenth Session of the United Nations Commission on Sustainable Development (CSD-19) on Building Partnerships for Moving Towards Zero Waste held from 16 to 18 February 2011 in Tokyo, Japan, the establishment of the International Partnership for Expanding Waste Management Services of Local Authorities (IPLA) was unanimously endorsed. IPLA was officially launched during CSD-19 held in New York in May 2011 and registered as one of the Rio+20 Partnerships in June 2012.


Currently IPLA unites over 240 registered members from 72 countries.

In accordance with the decision of the United Nations Commission on Sustainable Development, United Nations Centre for Regional Development (UNCRD) acts as a Coordinating Secretariat of IPLA and develops the Partnership since 2011.

The main objective of the Partnership is to help bring together local authorities and the private sector to develop public-private partnerships to tackle the waste problem and to create a conducive investment climate for expanding waste management services of local and municipal authorities. This corresponds with the objectives declared on the World Summit RIO+20, which took place in 2012 in Brazil, and meets the needs for sustainable development of all humankind.
