

2. How to get to the UN and the venue

The UN Headquarters is on 1st Avenue between 42nd Street and 48th Street.

Using public transportation is recommended for visiting the UN as the UN Headquarters does not offer parking facilities. The Visitors' Entrance is currently located at 47th St. and 1st Ave.

• By subway:

Numbers 4, 5, 6, 7, or S trains to Grand Central Station; walk toward east on 42nd – 47th Streets to 1st Avenue

• By bus:

Enter the Visitors' Entrance at 47th Street on 1st Avenue (East side of the avenue). After the entrance, on the left, there is a small cottage-like security check point where all visitors have to go through. Once a visitor is out of the security check point, the North Lawn (temporary) Conference Building is right in front. Follow walk way that leads to the basement of the Conference Building.

Conference room C is on the basement of the Conference Building. There will be a security machine at the entrance of the building. The UN Security guard will also be standing and the visitors have to show him a pass. Please walk straight on the corridor and you will find the Conference Room C on your right.

The Conference Room C is located in the same building where the Second Meeting of High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) will be held. If you are participates in the morning session of the HLPF, please use an elevator in the building to go down to the basement. After the elevator, please walk to the left and you will find the Conference Room C on your right.
